Nov. 16, 2023, Regular Board Meeting Summary

At the Nov. 16, 2023, Regular Board Meeting, the Board:

- Approved resolutions in support of <u>Indigenous Peoples' Day</u>, <u>Sikh Heritage Month</u>, <u>Native American Heritage Month</u>, and <u>Adoption Month</u>. The Board also presented the Native American Heritage Month resolution to Joshina Cluff, Chairwoman of the American Indian Parent Committee and Mike Duncan, Executive Director of the Native Dads Network.
- Approved the 2023-2024 Comprehensive Safety Plans for Secondary School Sites, including <u>Douglass Middle School</u>, <u>Lee Middle School</u>, <u>Cache Creek High School</u>, <u>Pioneer High School</u>, and <u>Woodland High School</u>.
- Reviewed the 2023-2024 Comprehensive School Safety Plans for Elementary School Sites, including <u>Beamer</u>, <u>Freeman</u>, <u>Dingle</u>, <u>Gibson</u>, <u>Maxwell</u>, <u>Plainfield</u>, <u>Prairie</u>, <u>Sci-Tech</u>, <u>Spring Lake</u>, <u>Tafoya</u>, <u>Whitehead</u>, and <u>Zamora</u> elementary schools, as well as <u>Woodland Adult Education</u>.
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>California Assessment of Student Performance</u>
 and <u>Progress (CAASPP) Results: Similar Districts</u>. District staff compared our
 CAASPP results to districts with similar student populations. Results for Spring
 2023 show Woodland students overall had slight increases from the previous
 year in both English Language Arts and Mathematics.
- Approved Resolution 14-24 to Waive Graduation Credits. This waives the
 graduation requirement of the Health, Life Skills development, and alignment with
 the Graduate Profile for current freshmen, the graduating class of 2027, and
 waives the CTE/Work readiness course graduation requirement for students who
 will graduate from Cache Creek High School with the class of 2024.

- Reviewed a <u>Quarterly Report on Williams Uniform Complaints</u>. There were no facility complaints filed during this quarter. No textbooks and instructional materials complaints were filed during this quarter as well.
- Reviewed a staff report on the <u>Average Daily Attendance (ADA) and Enrollment Report for the 2023-24 School Year</u> during Month 3 (8/14/23 9/08/23) and Month 4 (9/11/23 10/06/23). Enrollment for Month 3 was 9,093 and ADA was 8,532. Enrollment for Month 4 was 9,070 and ADA was 8,545.
- Approved Resolution 20-24 Annual and Five Year Reportable Fees Report for Fiscal Year 2022-23.
- Reviewed a report on <u>2022-23 Capital Facilities Fund (Mitigation Fees) Income</u> and Expenditures.
- Approved a <u>Variable Term Waiver Request for Single Subject Credential: Math.</u>
 This allows our District to fill a vacant position with an immediate need due to a statewide teacher shortage.
- Approved a <u>Variable Term Waiver Request for Multiple Subject Credential</u>. This
 allows our District to fill a vacant position with an immediate need due to a
 statewide teacher shortage.
- Held a <u>Public Hearing and Approved/Ratified the Tentative Agreement for the</u> 2023-2024 Reopener Negotiations between the California School Employees <u>Association and its Woodland Chapter #118 ("CSEA") and WJUSD.</u>
- Held a <u>Public Hearing and Approved/Ratified the Tentative Agreement for the</u>
 2023-2024 Reopener Negotiations between the Woodland Education Association
 ("WEA") and WJUSD.
- Reviewed the Process for Election of the Board Officers for 2024.
- Reviewed the <u>Review Process for Subcommittee Appointments for 2024</u>.
- Reviewed the 2024 Board Meeting Schedule Draft.
