Resolution 23-22: Adoption Month - November 2021

WHEREAS, Woodland Joint Unified School District understands that loving and nurturing families are strengthened and expanded when committed and dedicated individuals make an important difference in the life of a child through adoption; and

WHEREAS, all children and youth deserve to grow, develop, and have their needs met by being placed with families who can offer a permanent home; and

WHEREAS, in a permanent home, children and youth can receive love, protection, stability, and a sense of acceptance; and

WHEREAS, children and youth waiting for adoptive parents and the families who have adopted deserve support from their communities and from public and private agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Woodland Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees:

- 1. Supports the goals and ideals of National Adoption Month;
- 2. Recognizes that every child should have a permanent and loving family; and
- 3. Encourages individuals within the local community to consider adoption during the month of November and all throughout the year.
