APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO WOODLAND JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Trustees of the Woodland Joint Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) for the implementation of the District's Measure Y school facilities bond program. The general purpose of the Committee is to confirm for the community that voterapproved bond proceeds will and have been spent on voter-approved projects under Measure Y of 2020.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

In November 2020, voters residing within the Woodland Joint Unified School District passed Measure Y. Measure Y is a \$44.2 General Obligation Bond Measure designed to improve the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval; Measure Y was passed with the approval of 61.49% of the voters.

Establishment of a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, State law requires that the Woodland Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees appoint a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to work with the District. The committee was formed on January 21, 2021 and it is necessary to fill its vacancies.

Committee Responsibilities and Membership

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure Y bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure Y bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure Y; and
- Present to the Board of Trustees in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure Y bond proceeds.

The Board of Trustees has adopted Bylaws which will govern the proceedings of the CBOC. A copy of the Bylaws is available on the District's web site.

Committee Members and Term

Appointments to the CBOC are made by the Board of Trustees. There will be a minimum of nine committee members. Members generally serve 2-year terms and may serve up to 3 consecutive terms. Some initial members will serve only 1-year terms to ensure the terms are staggered in accordance with the Bylaws.
