Service (notetaker)</p> <p>III. <u>Ethnic Studies Training Update:</u></p> <p>Christina went over a handout about the Ethnic Studies Trainings. The handout lets us know where the teachers are at with the program and how they are implementing the course work in their classroom.</p> <p>Marjory shared how she is implementing the studies in her classroom. All teachers that did the trainings last year are in Cohort 1 for this school year. They are doing more in class work and share with the group when they meet with the Acosta Learning staff.</p> <p>All secondary Social Science teachers are being trained this school year. These teachers get a full day of training that consist of half day training from UCD and the second half from Acosta Learning. This will lead to a pilot for new curriculum/textbooks in Social Science. We are thinking about extending the training for next school year to VAPA classes.</p> <p>Christina shared the poem “In Lak’ech” by Luis Valdez. She will be sending copies of it to teachers so they can have it in their classroom.</p> <p>Our district is ahead of the game with Ethnic Studies.
