ABOUT THE PROJECT

We are looking for parents and guardians to help us design a research study. The study will look at how the use of telehealth for treating injured children in the emergency room impacts the family experience.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

As a parent representative, you will advise the UC Davis clinical research team.

Tasks include:

- Participating in four meetings (online and in-person) per year from 2020 - 2023
- Offering feedback to improve clinician-patient communication
- Reviewing research materials and providing feedback via email or phone

*No prior research experience required.

BENEFITS

- Payment for time is ~\$800/year plus travel expenses
- Covered childcare costs during meetings
- Ensuring the patient and caregiver perspectives are understood by researchers

WHAT IS TELEHEALTH?

Telehealth allows local emergency rooms to use video conferencing to connect families and their local doctors with pediatric trauma experts in Sacramento for cases involving injured children.
