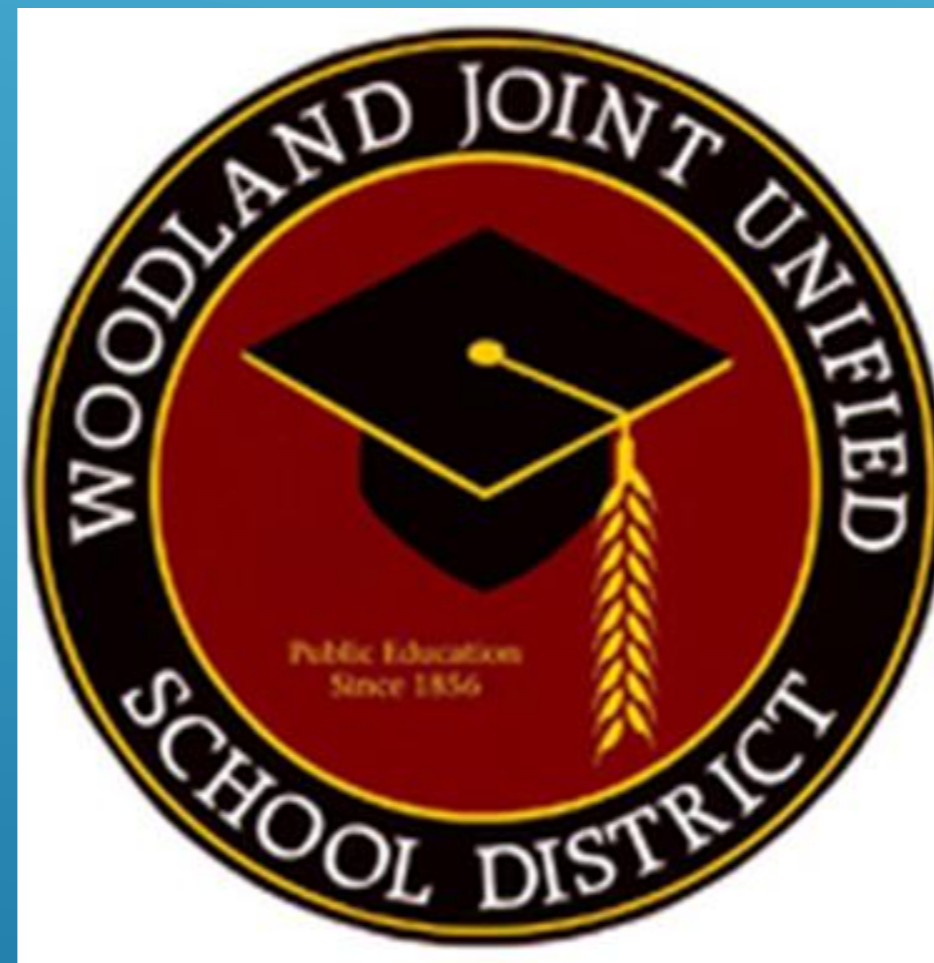


Planning For The Fall: Reopening Task Force and Advisory Committee

In an effort to decide on how to tackle the challenge of reopening schools in the fall, the district has taken the path of gathering input from as many stakeholders as possible. We have formed a School Reopening Task Force and we have formed an Advisory Committee to report to the Task Force. We have also sent out polls asking parents and students their thoughts. In addition to input, we are watching the State budget situation very closely to help ascertain the amount of resources we will have available to us in the fall. Our goal is to be able to provide a recommendation to the Board at the June 25th regular board meeting.

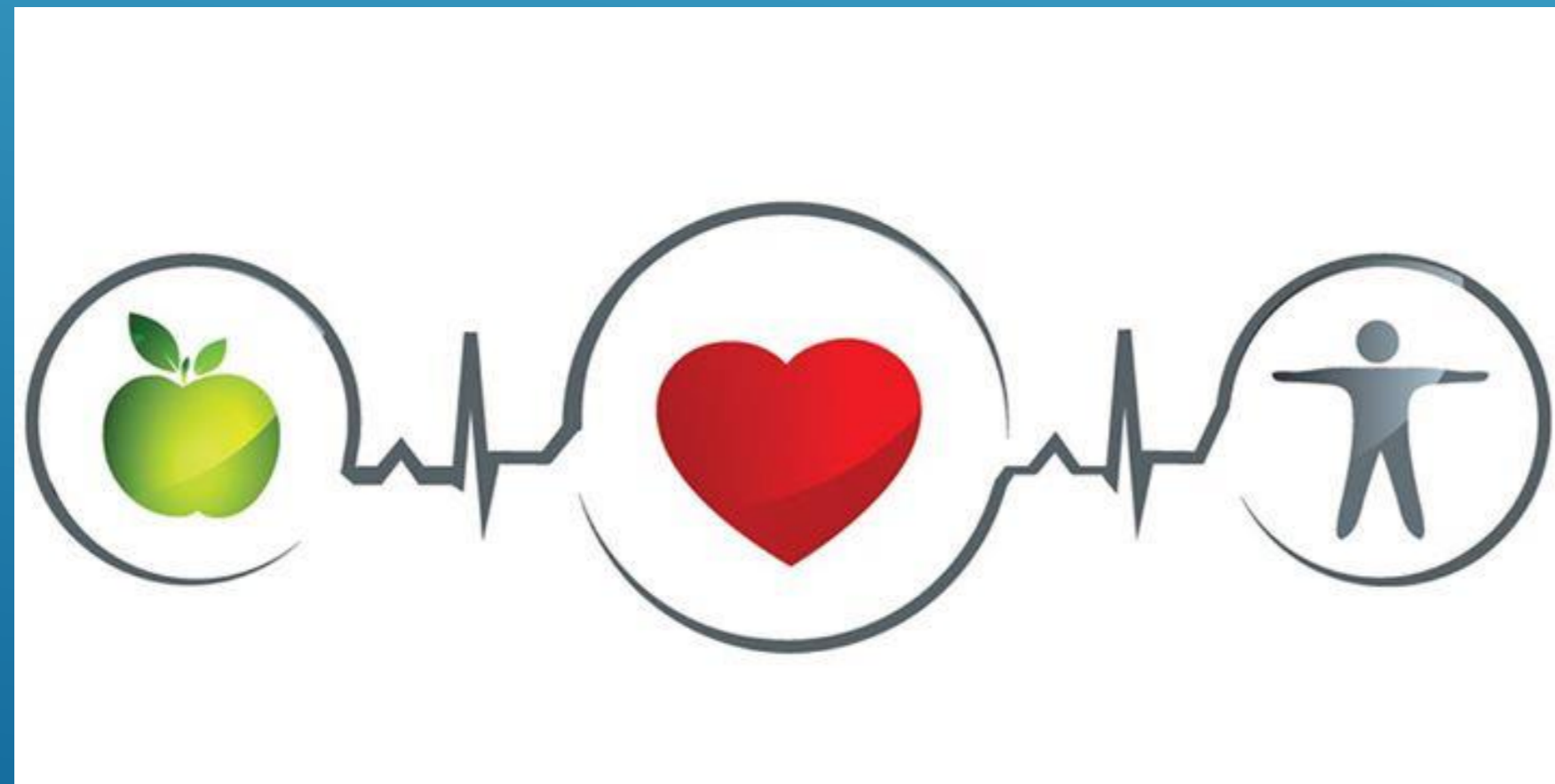

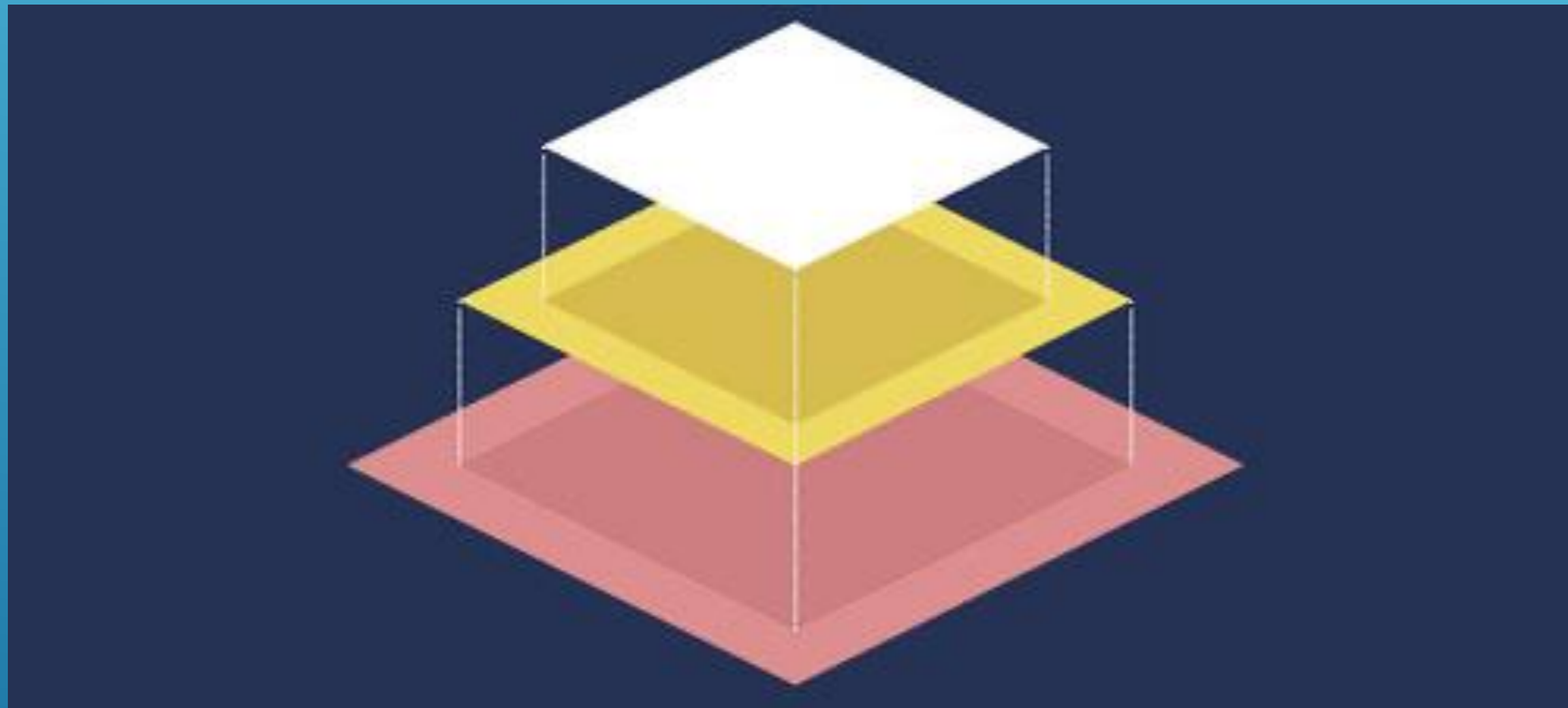
