# Guiding Criteria: Opening School 20-21



## Ensure the safety of all students and staff

We will follow State and local executive orders, and recommended State and local guidelines related to student and staff safety to the best of our ability.

## Support social-emotional needs



We will support staff in helping students learning how to manage stress, maintain motivation, and building self-confidence.

## Maximize student engagement



We will provide rigorous daily instruction, use an online learning management system for grading and attendance, and we will look at ways for students to stay connected to our schools as well as their peers.

## Support staff and parent needs

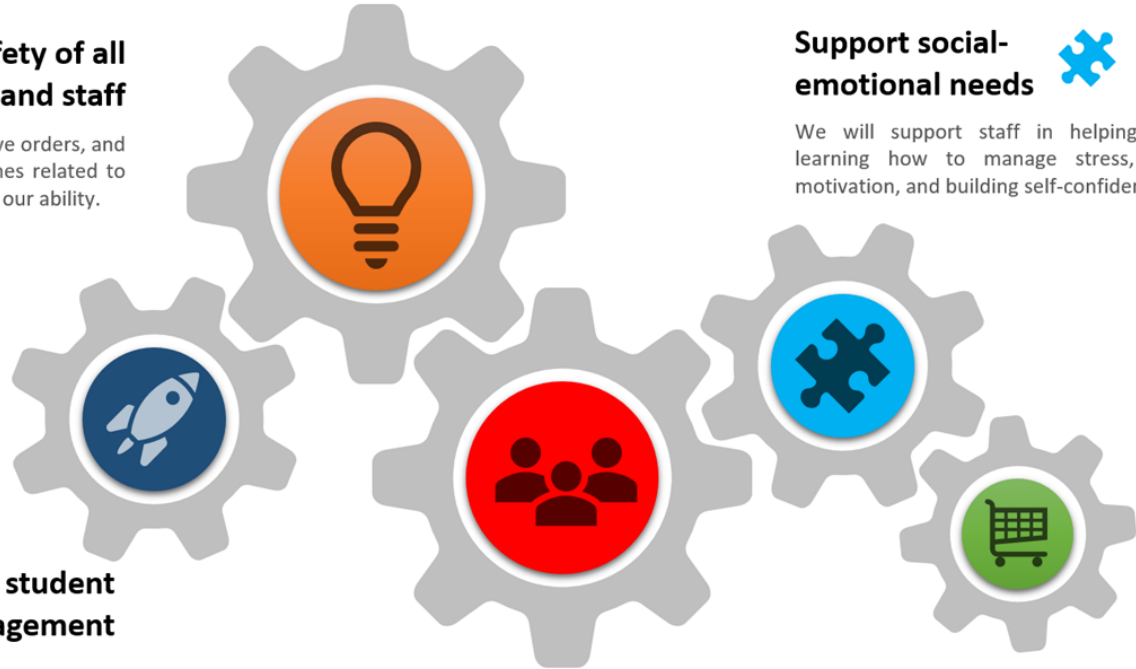


We will provide targeted and relevant staff development for our employees as well as our parents.

## Assure operational and financial viability



We will work within our projected budget and attempt to acquire resources to support student learning, health, and safety.



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## What is a Phased-in Approach?

- Start the school year in Remote Learning from home
- Monitor the health conditions in our community
- Gradually return to in-person instruction, as conditions permit



# WJUSD RECOMMENDED REOPENING PLAN

A Phased Approach to Reopening Schools



## PHASE 1

REMOTE LEARNING

All Virtual Instruction  
No In-Person Learning

## PHASE 2

LIMITED BLENDED LEARNING

Physical Distancing of 6 Feet  
No Groups Over 10 Students  
Active Screening in Place  
Face Coverings Required  
Health and Safety Protocols in Place

## PHASE 3

FULL BLENDED LEARNING

Physical Distancing of 6 Feet  
No Groups Over 50% of Classroom Capacity  
Passive Screening in Place  
Face Coverings Required  
Health and Safety Protocols in Place

## PHASE 4

IN-PERSON LEARNING WITH RESTRICTIONS

Physical Distancing to the Extent Possible  
Normal Class Capacity (minus those students in the Virtual Academy)  
Passive Screening in Place  
Face Coverings Required  
Health and Safety Protocols in Place

## PHASE 5

IN-PERSON LEARNING WITH NO RESTRICTIONS

Full In-Person Learning with No Restrictions

**K-12 VIRTUAL ACADEMY**

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## Phase 1 - Remote Learning



- All classrooms are closed and all learning is conducted remotely from home.
- The Grab-and-Go option will be available at multiple locations for students participating in Remote Learning and the Virtual Academy.
- Student Support Services will support staff in helping students in goal setting, learning how to manage stress, maintain motivation, and building self-confidence.

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## Phase 2 - Limited Blended Learning



- Very limited return to in-person learning, prioritized by student group
- Health precautions will be put in place
  - Physical distancing of 6 feet
  - Active screening
  - Face coverings required
  - Implementing health and safety protocols
- The Grab-and-Go option will be available at multiple locations for students participating in Home/Remote Learning and the Virtual Academy
- Training and conditioning activities may begin

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## Phase 3 - Full Blended Learning

- Blended learning at all levels
- Desks/tables will be placed at least six feet apart
- Face Coverings will be required
- Access to school buildings will be limited to students, staff, and essential personnel
- Social distancing requirements will significantly impact the capacity of each bus



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# Phase 4 - In-person Learning with Restrictions

- Most students return to in-person learning
- Food may be served in the classroom and the cafeteria, in alignment with any applicable federal, state, and local health orders
- Normal service would be provided to eligible students
- Health Precautions
  - Physical distancing to the extent possible
  - Passive screening
  - Face coverings required
  - Continue health and safety protocols





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# Phase 5 - In-person Learning with No Restrictions

- Phase 5 is when all students will be able to return to in-person learning without pandemic-related health and safety measures.
- Schools will be in normal operations. Students will attend class daily.
- Students who have been enrolled in the Virtual Academy will continue to be supported if they wish to continue full time home learning.

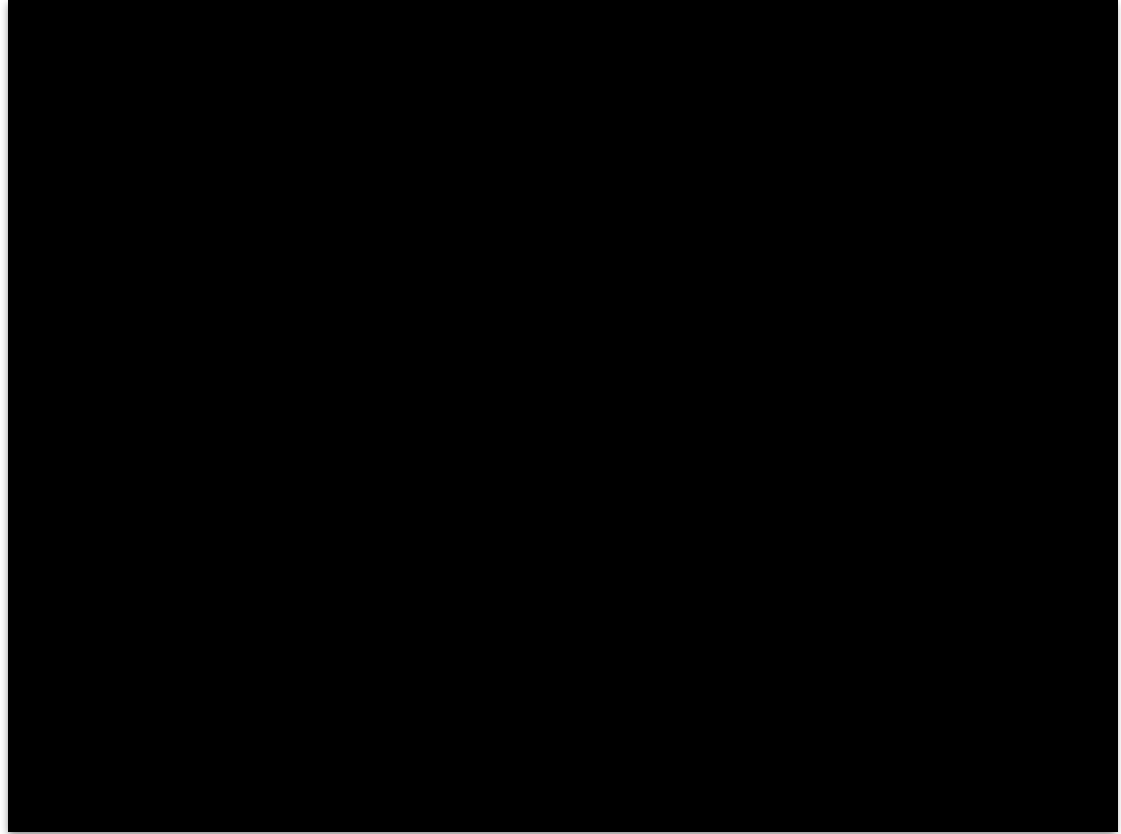
